ELLIS ELLIS (16xx-1706)

[The following is excerpted from History of Delaware County, Pennsylvania by George Smith M.D., published by Henry B. Ashmead in Philadelphia in 1862.]

ELLIS ELLIS, emigrated with his father, Thomas Ellis, in 1683, from Redstone in Pembrokeshire, Wales, and settled on part of the large purchase made by his father in Haverford township. In 1685 he was married to Lydia, the daughter of Elizabeth Humphrey, who had also emigrated in 1683, but she with her family came from Merionethshire. He was a Friend and a good citizen. His children were:
