DANIEL MEDLICOT (16xx-1697)

[The following is excerpted from <u>History of Delaware County, Pennsylvania</u> by George Smith M.D., published by Henry B. Ashmead in Philadelphia in 1862.]

DANIEL MEDLICOT brought a certificate from the monthly meeting of Salop, in Shropshire [England], and at first settled in Philadelphia, where in the latter part of the year 1684, he was married according to the usages of Friends, to Martha Sankey. Shortly after his marriage he settled among the Welsh Friends of Haverford, where he died in 1697, leaving but one child, Mary Medlicot. His wife also brought her certificate from Salop meeting.

DANIEL MEDLICOT, buried 9 Mo. 1, 1693.

MARY MEDLICOT, daughter of Daniel and Martha, was born 7 mo. 7, 1687. Birth recorded at Merion Meeting. Daniel Medlicot and Martha Sankee were married 10 mo. 2 1684. Marriage recorded in Philadelphia Meeting of Friends. Daniel died 1697, leaving widow, Martha, and one child, Mary. Other children may have died before their father.
