J. LEEDOM MOORE, treasurer of Haverford Township, resides at "Aurome," Manoa, Upper Darby. Mr. Moore is identified in the feed business as one of the representative business men of the county. Born in 1884, on April 19th, the son of Samuel H. and Mary Leedom Moore. He is a member of the Masonic fraternity and of Lu Lu Temple, of the Mystic Shrine. He is a member of the Brookline Square Club, the Aronimink Golf Club and the Rolling Green Golf Club. It need hardly be added, therefore, that his hobby is the ancient and honorable game of golf. His one other outstanding hobby might be given as community affairs, since he is an indefatigable worker in all things as relate to his neighborhood betterment. Mr. Moore, in politics, is a rock-ribbed Republican, being elected to his present office in November, 1923. He is married, his wife being Elizabeth Scuderling Moore, and their children being:
