## **OWEN MORGAN (16xx-1704)**

**OWEN MORGAN**, with his wife Jannie Morgan, came from the parish of Machanlleth, in Montgomeryshire, Wales, in 1684, and settled in Haverford. He was a man of limited means, and appears to have owned no land in Haverford. He was a Friend in good standing. After the death of his wife, he, in 1694, married Blanche, the widow of William Sharpus, and removed to Newtown, where he died in 1704. Blanche survived him till 1717, at which time she appeared to be in easy circumstances.
