FRED R. PERRY (1884-19xx)

FRED R. PERRY, of Llanerch. heads the huge drug company bearing his name throughout eastern Delaware County and Philadelphia, and was a real pioneer in the developing of retail business in the eastern end of our county. He was born in 1884, on September 23rd. the son of James C. and Ada McGuin Perry. A member of Concordia Lodge, No. 67, F. & A. M., and of Lu Lu Temple, Mystic Shrine, and the Elks. He numbers among his clubs the Penn Athletic and Whitemarsh Country. His wife is Anna Conlin Perry, and they have one daughter. Marjorie. In politics, Republican. As for hobbies he runs strong for the ancient and honorable game of golf, although an indefatigable gunner in season, being a lover of the great out-doors.
