WILLIAM SHARPUS (16xx-1684)

WILLIAM SHARPUS emigrated from Trererigg in Glamorganshire, Wales, and settled in Haverford in 1683. He died in November of the next year, and was the first person buried in the grave-yard belonging to Haverford Meeting. His widow, Blanche, was [re-]married to Owen Morgan [widower, also of Haverford, in 1694]. His daughter, **MARY SHARPUS**, was married [at the Old Haverford Meeting House] to William Bevan of Newtown in 1705.
