



J. BORTON WEEKS, Attorney-at-Law, and member of the firm Taylor, Chadwick and Weeks, Chester, Pa. Mr. Weeks resides at Brookline, Haverford Township. His clubs are the Chester, Springhaven, Brinton Lake, Penn Athletic, Keystone Automobile, Pen and Pencil, Brookline Square, Craftsman's, Ben Franklin and Kiwanis. His fraternities are the Delta Chi (U. of P.), Geo. W. Bartram Lodge, F: & A. M., Media Royal Arch Chapter 24, and a member of the American Legion. His societies are the Delaware County Historical, American Bar Association, Penna. Bar Association, Delaware County Bar Association. He was born February 3rd, 1891, his father being Joseph H.
